Alpine Poncho

One Size

Finished length: approximately 17 inches to the point

Materials:

3 50g balls Scheepjes Alpine
10mm 80 cm circular needle
12mm circular needle (optional)
stitch markers

Gauge: Gauge is not critical for this project. Note: if you want to make the poncho longer, purchase additional Alpine.

Poncho is worked in one piece.

With Alpine, cast on 70 sts. Join being careful not to twist, placing a marker at the start of the round.

Round 1: Purl

Round 2: K17, yo, k1, yo, k34, yo, k1, yo, k17 (74 sts)

Round 3: Knit

Round 4: K18, yo, k1, yo, k36, yo, k1, yo, k18 (78 sts)

Round 5: Knit

Round 6: K19, yo, k1, yo, k38, yo, k1, yo, k19 (82 sts)

Round 7: Knit

Keeping continuity of pattern as established, continue increases (four inc every other round) as set until you have 162 sts on the needle. End with a knit round.

Next round: Purl. Cast off very loosely in purl. Use 12mm needle if necessary.

With 10mm needle, pick up and knit approximately 60 sts around neck edge. Purl one row. Cast off loosely in purl. Weave in ends.
