

**TURQUOISE SHORT JACKET WITH FANCY BORDERS**

Sizes: 8/10 (12/14)

Medium difficulty

**MATERIALS**

300 (350) gms MADIL YARN Eden Print turquoise n. 036; knitting needles size 6 US/4 1/2 mm; tapestry needle; 6 buttons

**STITCHES USED**

**stockinette stitch** (stock st)

**reverse stockinette stitch** (rev stock st)

**candle flames pattern** (multiple of 4 sts + 3): follow chart

**3 sts in 1 st:** in same st work: k 1, p 1 and k 1

**to inc 1 st:** raise 1 (k 1 then k 1 into back loop of the corresponding st below).

**GAUGE**

18 sts and 25 rows = 10 cm square over stock st

**WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Back:** cast on 73 (77) sts and work in stock st. At 14 (16) cm from beg of work, 36 (41) rows, inc each side, within 2 edge sts, 1 st and 1 more st after 22 rows. At 25.5 (27.5) cm from beg, 64 (69) rows, to shape armholes bind off each side, every other row, 4 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st once. At 17 (18) cm from beg of armholes, 42 (44) rows, to shape neckline bind off center 37 (41) sts and cont each part separately binding off at neck edge 3 sts after 2 rows. At 2 rows from beg of neckline to shape shoulders bind off each side every other row 5 sts twice.

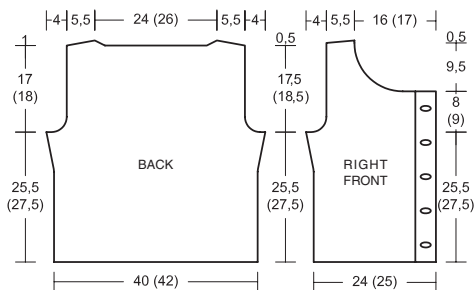
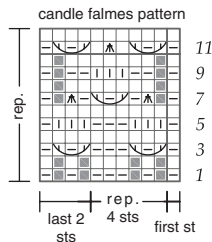
**Right front:** cast on 44 (46) sts and set work as foll: rev stock st over 2 sts, candle flames patt over 7 sts, stock st over 35 (37) sts. At 3 cm from beg (8 rows) RH, within first 4 sts, make a buttonhole every 16 (17) rows 5 times (bind off 3 sts and cast them on in foll row). At 14 (16) cm from beg, 36 (41) rows, inc LH, within 2 sts, 1 st and 1 more st after 22 rows. At 25.5 (27.5) cm from beg, 64 (69) rows, to shape armhole bind off LH, every other row, 4 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st once. At 8 (9) cm from beg of armhole, 20 (22) rows, to shape neckline let stand border sts (=13 sts on the 12th row of candle flames patt) and the foll 5 sts, then bind off every other row, 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st 5 times. At 9.5 cm from beg of neckline (24 rows) to shape shoulder bind off LH every other row 5 sts twice.

**Left front:** work to match right front, reversing shapings and omitting buttonholes.

**Sleeves:** cast on 49 (53) sts and work border in candle flames patt for 9 rows (4 cm) allowing 1 (3) selvedge st (sts) each side (start from the 3rd row of patt and replace the 11th row of patt working 1 rows as foll: 1 (3) selvedge st (sts), \* p 3, p 3 tog \*, rep from \* to \*, end p 3, 1 (3) selvedge st (sts)). Cont in stock st (p 1st row on WS of work). At 2 cm from border (5 rows) inc each side, within 2 sts, 1 st, 1 st after 4 rows and 1 more st after 2 rows. At 5 cm from border (13 rows) to shape cap bind off each side, every other row, 4 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st 10 (11) times, 2 sts twice. At 11 (12) cm from beg of cap, 28 (30) rows, bind off rem 15 sts.

**FINISHING**

Join shoulder seams. Cont in candle flames patt over standing 13 sts of right front border, knit up 93 (101) sts along neckline (k standing sts), cont in candle flames patt over sts of left front neckline. Work over all sts for 10 rows in candle flames patt allowing 2 sts in rev stock st each side (on the 1st row, WS, work the 13 border sts as they face you, p knit up sts). Across the 5th row of border make a buttonhole on the right front border on top of those below. Bind off all sts in last row (before bind off p tog the 3 sts of patt with the knitted side facing you, p all other sts and omit working 3 sts in 1). Join side seams. Sew and mount sleeves. Sew buttons facing buttonholes.



**KEY:**

- = k1
- = p1
- = p3 tog
- = has no meaning
- = 3 sts in 1 foundation st

Each square = 1 st and 1 row  
On even rows work sts as they face you
