Watercolours and Malizia Scarf or Stole

Finished Measurements

8 inches wide x 50 inches long for scarf

22 inches wide x 70 inches long for stole

Materials and Tools

2 balls Watercolours (Main color = MC) for scarf.

6 balls Watercolours (Main color = MC) for stole.

1 ball Malizia (Contrast color = CC)

1 pair 6 ½ mm needles

1 sewing needle

Note: Watercolours is used double through out both the scarf and stole.

Method

With MC cast on 27 stitches for scarf.

Row 1: (k1, p1) x2, [k3, (p1, k1) x2, p1] x2, k3, (p1, k1) x2.

Row 2: (k1, p1) x2, [p3, (p1, k1) x2, p1] x2, p3, (p1, k1) x2.

With MC cast on 59 sts for stole.

Row 1: (k1, p1) x2, [k3, (p1, k1) x2, p1] x6, k3, (p1, k1) x2.

Row 2: (k1, p1) x2, [p3, (p1, k1) x2, p1] x6, p3, (p1, k1) x2.

Repeat these two rows until you have 2 yards of yarn left. Cast off loosely.

Finishing

Cut 9 strands of CC yarn 56 inches long for the scarf.

Cut 21 strands of CC yarn 76 inches long for the stole.

With right side facing weave a strand vertically into and out of the center of each of the three stocking stitches (k3, stitches). When all the strands have been woven, stretch the scarf very gently, then weave in the ends on the wrong side.
