

Free Pattern CADENZA OR AREQUIPA

Feather and Fan Shawl or Scarf

<u>Shawl</u>

3 100g skeins of either Estelle Arequipa or Cadenza 5mm needles

Finished measurements (after blocking): approximately 21 ½ x 60 inches (Arequipa has greater yardage than Cadenza therefore Cadenza shawl may be shorter in length)

Gauge is not critical for this shawl.

Feather and Fan Pattern (18 stitch repeat)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K2tog three times, (YO K1) six times, K2tog three times

Row 4: Knit

Cast on 126 sts. Knit 6 rows in garter stitch increasing 6 sts evenly on last row (132 sts). Commence Feather & Fan pattern starting with row 1 as follows:

Row 1: K3, work row 1 of Feather & Fan Pattern to last 3 sts, K3

Row 2: K3, work row 2 of Feather & Fan Pattern to last 3 sts, K3

Row 3: K3, work row 3 of Feather & Fan Pattern to last 3 sts, K3

Row 4: K3, work row 4 of Feather & Fan Pattern to last 3 sts, K3

Continue until shawl measures approximately 53 inches or desired length. Work 6 rows of garter stitch, decreasing 6 sts evenly on first row. Cast off loosely. Block shawl if desired.

Scarf

1 100g skein of either Estelle Arequipa or Cadenza

5mm needles

Finished measurements (after blocking): approximately 9 x 45 inches (Arequipa has greater yardage than Cadenza therefore Cadenza scarf may be shorter in length)

Gauge is not critical for this scarf.

Cast on 54 sts. Knit 6 rows in garter stitch increasing 6 sts evenly on last row (60 sts). Commence Feather & Fan pattern as for shawl starting with row 1.

Continue until scarf measures approximately 45 inches or desired length. Work 6 rows of garter stitch, decreasing 6 sts evenly on first row. Cast off loosely. Block scarf if desired.
